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- By way of two case studies the chapter examines how community radio promotes an African American voice: How does it provide voice to an otherwise voiceless community? The chapter looks at the role that community radio plays in the minority community itself and to what extent community involvement helps to maintain community radio. The two radio stations (both owned and controlled by African Americans) that are being looked at are KUCB in Des Moines, Iowa, and Black Liberation Radio in Springfield, Illinois
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
