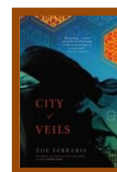


Magliota takes bumpy ride into male-dominated world of heart surgeons. She tries balancing the multiple roles of cardio-surgeon, mother, and wife.

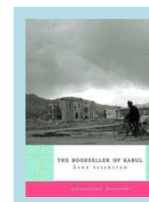


Leila is beaten and brutally murdered. How is the violent death of a woman solved?

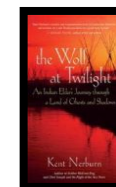


IRONY! Sultan, the bookseller, risks his life to protect books from the Taliban. But he refuses his son an education, and dooms females to drudgery and humiliation.

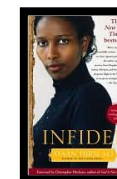


Nerburn is led by Lakota elder in a search for Yellow Bird, his sister who disappears at government school where the curriculum is more cultural homicide than education.
