Complete Speech and Hearing Evaluation
Satisfy LAC 1A—Selected Writing Course
Satisfy LAC 1B—Oral Communication
Pass Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST) in Reading, Mathematics, and Writing
Demonstrate Acceptable Dispositions (absence of Notification of Concern)

Fulfill successfully any additional requirements as prescribed by the Council on Teacher Education
Declare a teaching major
Majors are strongly encouraged to also complete a background check with the Department of Criminal Investigation
