The management and analysis of student outcomes assessment data can be a daunting task. Fortunately, our IT staff have worked with UNI faculty to develop the UNI Performance Assessment System (UNIPAS). UNIPAS, a web-based system, allows assessment data to be entered at the course or program level, incorporates data from the registrar as needed, and provides data management and reporting functions. The brown bag session will include a brief live demonstration with time for questions and answers.
