## **SEARCH THE INTERNET**

---

Use search engines or subject directories ([www.library.uni.edu/dbandcat/search.shtml](http://www.library.uni.edu/dbandcat/search.shtml)) to search the Internet. Use keywords such as the name of the field plus careers or jobs - e.g. "careers in graphic design" or "photography jobs." Use phrases such as "what can I do with a major in ..." with the name of the field of interest - e.g. "what can I do with a major in art." Look for categories such as "jobs" or "careers" in subject directories available on the Internet.

## UNI LIBRARIES

Use subject or keyword to search the UNI libraries ([Career Services Library](#), [Rod Library](#), etc.) for information on specific occupations. Enter the career field followed by the phrase "vocational guidance," e.g. art - vocational guidance. Other subject terms are: "career development," "occupations," "professions," "job descriptions."
