The Department of labor provides a searchable database of those employers who have hired H-1B. You can search by state, employer, or occupation family. Go to the end of the Web page, choose the **Work State** (e.g. Iowa) and you will get a list of employers in Iowa who have applied to hire a foreign professional worker. You can get company name, address, job title, person in the company who filed, etc. Under **File to Search** you can also search previous years.
