A one-time \$500 (minimum) scholarship will be awarded to former participants that will attend the University of Northern Iowa. Students who have met the criteria and wish to apply for the scholarship must complete the following:

- A one-page reference from the team advisor discussing the applicant's involvement and contributions.
- An essay, power point or video presentation describing the applicant's team involvement.
- A one-paragraph teammate reference regarding the applicant's contributions and positive attributes to the team.
- An oral interview with the Iowa Electrathon Scholarship Committee.

Applications must be submitted by **June 1, 2007**. The Iowa Electrathon helps participants develop valuable math, science, technology, communication, and business skills. This scholarship will help these students start on the right track.
