QUALIFICATIONS:

Doctoral or terminal degree in music required by time of appointment. Demonstrated ability in professional singing and collegiate teaching and proficiency in English, German, French and Italian languages required.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide instruction to undergraduate and graduate voice majors. Active performance expected – solo, chamber and other recital/ensemble appearances. Other teaching assigned according to departmental need and instructor's area(s) of expertise (such as Diction and Song Literature courses). Actively recruit and advise voice students.
