2. Dean Lubker's Remarks.

Senators shared feedback to the clinical track faculty draft proposal which had been distributed to all members of the college. The senate will continue discussions at future meetings.

CHFA needs to appoint a faculty member to serve on the selection committee for the Class of 1943 Faculty Award for Excellence in Teaching and Ross A. Nielsen Outstanding Service Award. Ronnie Bankston will contact past recipients to determine who is willing to serve this year.
