Endorsement in Education of the Gifted

The University of Northern Iowa is proposing to offer an Education of the Gifted Endorsement beginning Fall 2009. Graduate students holding a current Iowa teaching certificate, or approved equivalent, may take the state-approved sequence of four courses to earn their endorsement.

Convenience through distance education

We recognize that multiple career and personal obligations, as well as travel limitations, may prevent you from taking courses on campus. As such, spring and fall courses for this program are offered Tuesday evenings, 6 to 9 p.m., via the Iowa Communications Network (ICN) and the web. The Summer 2010 course will be delivered asynchronously through an online web format during the June four-week session.

Tuition and fees

Graduate tuition is \$374 per credit hour for 2009–10, plus a technology fee of approximately \$25 per course. Tuition and fees may increase in subsequent years.

Funding available Graduate students enrolled in the Education of the Gifted program may be able to receive federal Teach Grant funds (up to \$4000 a year for two years) if they will be teaching at low income schools.
