## Endorsement in *Education of the Gifted*



The University of Northern Iowa is proposing to offer an Education of the Gifted Endorsement beginning Fall 2008. Graduate students holding a current Iowa teaching certificate, or approved equivalent, may take the state-approved sequence of four courses to earn their endorsement.

### Convenience through distance education

We recognize that multiple career and personal obligations, as well as travel limitations, may prevent you from taking courses on campus. As such, spring and fall courses for this program are offered Tuesday evenings, 6 to 9 p.m., via the Iowa Communications Network (ICN) and the web. Dates and times for the Summer 2009 course have not been decided.

### Tuition and fees

Graduate tuition is \$359 per credit hour for 2008-09, plus a \$24.25 technology fee per course. Tuition and fees may increase slightly in subsequent years.

### 210:257 Coordinating Programs for the Gifted & Talented

Methods/procedures for coordinating/directing school district PK-12 programs for the gifted and talented. Emphasis on program planning, management, supervision, and evaluation.

*Satisfies "administration and supervision of gifted programs" state requirement*

## Fall 2009

### 210:297 Practicum for the Gifted & Talented

*Satisfies "practicum" state requirement*
