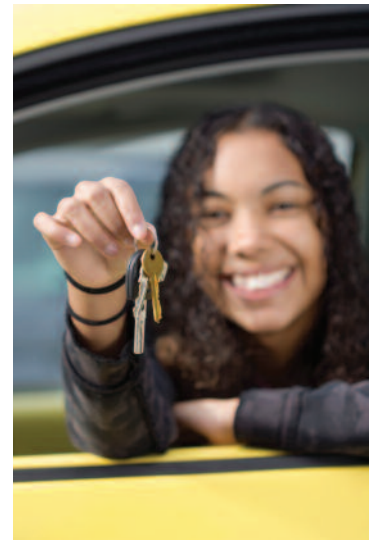


Driver Education Endorsement courses to begin this fall

As a result of recent changes approved by the Board of Educational Examiners, teachers may now earn the Driver Education (7-12) Endorsement by completing nine semester hours of credit that includes course work in accident prevention, drug and alcohol abuse, vehicle safety and behind-the-wheel driving.

For licensed secondary teachers, completion of the endorsement courses authorizes both classroom and behind-the-wheel driving.
