## NRHH Application

- Since 1984 the University of Northern Iowa Chapter of the National Residence Hall Honorary has inducted University of Northern Iowa students as new members into its ranks. Membership is limited to 1% (approximately 40) of the residence hall population in a given year.
- The induction of NRHH members at the annual Among the Stars Awards and Reception in April dates back to 1989.
- Selection to NRHH and “active member” status means a commitment of at least 20 hours involvement in NRHH projects throughout the subsequent academic year. Please apply only if you intend to fulfill this expectation, which is designed to help NRHH continue the important work of recognizing excellence in contributions to community. (This expectation applies only to applicants who will live on campus next year.)

S/he will complete the back of this page and submit the whole thing for you. **Applications are due by March 25<sup>th</sup>—so please make sure to submit this to your Coordinator in time for them to complete it by that deadline.**
