The program's purposes are to provide insight about how to be an effective GLBTQ (Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Trans-gender, Questioning) ally and to provide a more connected network among UNI allies.



Anyone may attend an orientation to the Safe Zone Ally Program. Everyone who attends and feels moved to become an ally is invited to do so at the conclusion of the orientation.
