Single rooms are available in limited numbers. Contracts should be submitted early to ensure consideration for these spaces. If a single room is requested, and a designed single is not available, if space allows, you will be assigned to a double room as a single and the room rate will be as indicated above. Residents' children and/or spouses cannot be housed in the residence hall.

Dining Services

All dining locations accept cash, dining dollars and allow u-bill charging to those that qualify. Hours for all dining will be posted in halls.

Meals are available in the Piazza Dining Center. Meals in the Piazza in Redeker Center begin with breakfast on June 9 and end with dinner on August 1. The Piazza is open Monday breakfast through Friday lunch. Serving times for meals will be posted in the hall. The Piazza accepts Dining Dollars, cash, or charge to U-Bill.

Room Furnishings

Each room includes single lofted beds, chest of drawers, desks, chairs and window blinds. Residents provide their own linens, pillow, towels, blanket, telephone (local phone service is provided) and other personal accessories. Refrigerators and stove/ovens are provided in kitchens in all living spaces. Microwaves are provided in suites. Refrigerators less than 4.5 cubic feet are permitted, along with microwave, TV, radio, stereo, hair dryer, popcorn popper, coffee pot and other small UL-approved appliances.
