Room Furnishings

Each room includes single lofted beds, chest of drawers, desks, chairs and window blinds. Residents provide their own linens, pillow, towels, blanket, cell phone and other personal accessories. Refrigerators, microwaves, and stove/ovens are provided in kitchens in all living spaces. Refrigerators less than 4.5 cubic feet are permitted, along with TV, stereo, hair dryer, popcorn popper, coffee pot and other small UL-approved appliances.
