ROTH Complex, Panther Village and Dancer Hall

Air conditioned space is available for guests who are staying a minimum of five consecutive nights. You will be able to choose air conditioned space during registration and your placement will be confirmed after registration. Air conditioned space is on a first come, first served basis and is limited.

Dancer Hall Features

Dancer Hall is close to academic buildings. Summer Conference Assistants are on call overnight in Dancer Hall to assist participants. Space is reserved on a first come, first served basis.

Dancer Hall has both single and double occupancy rooms. All rooms are furnished with beds, desks, dressers, closets, and a sink. Linen service includes sheets, pillow, blanket, and two towels. Dancer Hall does have air-conditioned lounges on each floor; however, the sleeping rooms are not air conditioned with the exception of six female rooms. On the ground floor there is an air conditioned recreation room for relaxing and watching television. A laundry room and a kitchen facility are located on the 1st Floor.

The Dancer Hall Office is open from 7:30 am to 10:00 pm, Monday through Friday and 12:00 pm to 10:00 pm, Saturday and Sunday. The office phone number is (319) 273-2376. If you arrive outside of these hours, the Summer Conference Assistant staff on-call is available to assist you by calling (319) 464-4157.

ROTH Complex

ROTH Complex is a short drive to academic buildings. Resident Assistants are on call overnight in ROTH Complex overnight to assist participants. Space is reserved on a first come, first served basis and is extremely limited.

ROTH Complex has single and double rooms that are furnished with beds, desks, dressers, and closets. Rooms are located either in suites or 2 and 3 bedroom apartments. Linen service includes sheets, pillow, blanket, and two towels. Every room in ROTH Complex is air-conditioned. There is a recreation room for relaxing and watching television. A laundry room is located on the ground level.

The ROTH Complex Office is open from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Thursday; 7:30 am to 4:00 pm Friday; and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm, Saturday and Sunday. The office phone number is (319) 273-7051. If you arrive outside of these hours, the Resident Assistant staff on-call is available to assist you by calling (319) 464-5231.

Panther Village

Panther Village is our newest residence hall and is an all apartment residence hall on campus. Resident Assistants are on call overnight in Panther Village overnight to assist participants. Space is reserved on a first come, first served basis and is extremely limited.

Panther Village has single bedrooms that are furnished with beds, desks, dressers, and closets. Rooms are located either

in 2 or 4 bedroom apartments. Linen service includes sheets, pillow, blanket, and two towels. Every room in Panther Village is air-conditioned. There is a Lobby / Living Room for relaxing and watching television. A laundry room is located on each level.

The Panther Village Office is open from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Thursday; 7:30 am to 4:00 pm Friday; and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm, Saturday and Sunday. The office phone number is (319) 273-7894. If you arrive outside of these hours, the Resident Assistant staff on-call is available to assist you by calling (319) 464-2592.

Room rates will be billed beginning with the first day of the workshop and ending with the last night of lodging. Because of limited housing opportunities, children and/or spouses of workshop participants are not able to be accommodated at any of the buildings.
