10 a.m. Department of Residence welcome and info session at the Center for Multicultural Education (CME) on the upper level of Maucker Union

(Take the staircase or the elevator or elevator at the NE corner of the fair)

11 a.m. Meet at the Department of Residence booth at the Student Services Fair if you want to see residence hall rooms in [Lawther](#), [Campbell](#), [Bender](#) or [Dancer](#)

11a.m. - noon More time at the Student Services Fair in Maucker Union (see options above)
