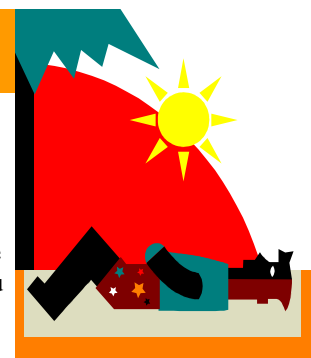
ISO will provide transportation for those who would like to enjoy the parade on **Sat Jun 25 @ 10 am**.
