Sturgis Falls Celebration

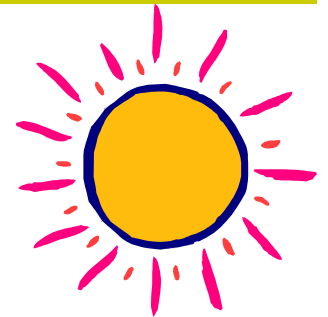
The 32nd Annual Sturgis Falls Celebration will be held June 22-24.

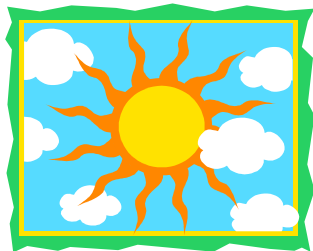
