- Sign up at ISO or call 3-6421 to let us know of your participation.

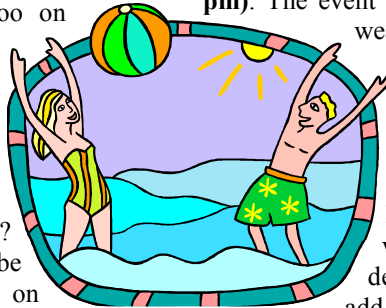
