## Data collection and surveys

Collecting data on paper is cumbersome. There are numerous options for collecting data on the web for research and assessment.

- **Microsoft FrontPage**  
With FrontPage data can be saved into a text file that can be imported into Excel or data can be saved directly to an

Access database. PC only.

- **FileMaker Pro**  
Another product that is relatively easy to use to make web-based forms is FileMaker Pro. Both PC and Mac.
- **WebCT**  
Although limited, WebCT provides an

easy-to-use survey tool.

- **Sources on the web**  
There are a variety of sources on the web ranging from survey-hosting sites to sites that provide the code for a form.
