# CatID

CatID



Your **CatID** (login credentials) at the University of Northern Iowa consists of your **username** and your **passphrase**. Your username is a unique 3-8 character account name that identifies you as a member of the UNI community. Your username is a permanent and visible part of your UNI identity:

- **For students, it appears in your UNI email address**  
*username@uni.edu*
- it appears in your UNI web page URL  
*www.uni.edu/username*
- it's your unique identifier and/or login ID in many of UNI's online systems

Your username in conjunction with your password allow you access to various online resources and computers on campus. Use your CatID wherever you see the **CatID logo** (see above). [What is my CatID passphrase?](#) [1]

Your UNI username will be with you throughout your affiliation with UNI. If you graduate from UNI, then return later as an employee, you'll retain the same username.
