HTML Tags

- Includes an inline image.
- Specifies how wide a border is around a picture.
- Aligns the inline image with the text. To see an example of a type, click on the word.
- A less detailed image over your image loads with your more detailed one building over it.
- This places the contents of the alt tag in the browser when the image doesn't load.
-
clear=all|left|right> Stops the word wrap from the <align=left | right> command.
- Puts space on either side of the picture.
- Puts space on the top and bottom of the picture.
- Specifies how large the picture should be displayed as.
- <embed src=path> Insert object into a page.
- <embed src=path width=#pixels height=#pixels> Object size.
