

# About the WebAccess Client

The WebAccess client is a browser-based application that looks and performs like a desktop application.

## **Hardware Requirements:**

The following are the hardware requirements for the WebAccess client. The minimum requirements let you use the WebAccess client without difficulty, while the recommended requirements will ensure a fast, efficient WebAccess client experience.

- Minimum required hardware: Pentium III 1 GHz CPU or equivalent (PowerPC G4 CPU or equivalent for Macintosh) with 256 MB RAM
- Recommended hardware: Pentium 4 2 GHz CPU or higher (PowerPC G4 1.33 GHz CPU or higher for Macintosh) with 512 MB RAM or more

## **Browsers and Javascript requirements**

The WebAccess client supports the following Web browsers:

- Internet Explorer 6 (Windows 2000 or XP)
- Mozilla 1.7.3 or later (Windows, Macintosh, Linux)
- Firefox 1.0 or later (Windows, Macintosh, Linux)

Netscape and Safari browsers are not supported. Accessibility mode is supported in Internet Explorer only.

To use the WebAccess client, you must also enable Javascript in your browser. The steps to do this are described on the WebAccess client sign-in page at <http://www.uni.edu/email>.
