

## **Installing Client Software on a Diskette or CDROM:**

The remote client software runs on any Windows 9x or higher so having a diskette or CD handy (in your briefcase or glove compartment) can enable you to use any Windows machine connected to the internet to access your host (work) computer. Any Windows XP Home or Professional computer system already has this software preloaded in it so you would not necessarily have to use a diskette or CD.

### **Manually creating a diskette or CD of necessary programs:**

Copy these three files to a diskette or CD from your Windows XP system:

C:\windows\system32\mstsc.exe  
C:\windows\system32\mstsc.chm  
C:\windows\system32\mstscax.dll

### **To run the installed software:**

Open the drive of the diskette or CD and launch (double-click) the **mstsc.exe** program
