

ITS Student Computer Centers (SCCs) Access

Students are admitted to the ITS SCCs (public labs) if they are one of the following:

1. A currently enrolled student.
2. A future enrolled student who has been admitted to UNI but as yet has not attended class.
3. A student that has had their faculty advisor requested access in consideration of special circumstances.
4. A graduate student that has had their faculty advisor request access to finish their thesis.

A student who had been eligible to be admitted to the SCC's would be denied access if their status changed in the following way:

1. They graduate or withdraw from the University.
2. They never registered for courses AND the semester they were scheduled to enter study at UNI has passed.
3. They were enrolled in the previous semester but are NOT enrolled in the current semester.

If a person who has been denied access to the SCC's subsequently registers for courses, they will be able to access the labs once their registration information has been completely processed. This registration information processing only occurs weekly on Friday evenings, this means SCC access would then start on Saturday.
