

Installing UNI dial up on Vista Business

*Download the uni.scp file from www.uni.edu/its/us/software (Dial-up access) and save it on your choice of removable media (burn to cd or save on usb flash drive)

On Destination computer

1. Go to the **start** menu
2. Click on **Connect to**
3. Click on **Set up a Connection or Network**
4. Choose **Set up a dial up connection**
5. Click **Next**
6. Enter **2732664** under “Dial up phone number”
7. Enter **UNI** as the “Connection Name” then Click **Connect**
8. Wait for **The internet connectivity test was unsuccessful** statement
9. Choose **Set up the Connection Anyway**
10. Click on **Close**

Create Desktop Shortcut

1. Go to the **Start** menu
2. Click on **Connect to**
3. Choose **Open Network and Sharing Center**
4. Choose **Manage Network Connections**
5. Right-Click on **UNI** and choose **Create Shortcut**
6. Click on **Yes** the close all windows

Transferring scripting files to local file:

1. Right click on the downloaded script file (uni.scp) and choose **copy (file is inside downloaded UNI.zip folder)**
2. Click on **Start**
3. Click on **Computer**
4. Double-click on the **C** drive (hard drive).
5. Double-click the **Windows** folder.
6. Double-click the **System32** folder.
7. Right click on **RAS** folder and choose **Paste**
8. Close window

Configuring UNI Dial-up:

1. Double-click on the **UNI dial-up** icon on the desktop.
2. Click on the **Properties** button towards the bottom of the page.
3. Select the **Security** tab at the top of the page.
4. Toward bottom of that page put a check next to **run script** then go to **Browse**.
5. If you are taken directly to the **RAS** folder, skip to step 10
6. Double-click the **C** Drive.
7. Double-click the **Windows** folder.
8. Double-click the **System32** folder.
9. Double-click the **RAS** folder
10. Double-click the **Uni.scp** file
11. Next go to the **Networking** tab.
12. Uncheck Internet Potocol Version 6 (if checked)
13. Click on Internet Protocol Version 4 then click on **Properties**
14. Choose “Use the following DNS server addresses”
15. Enter **134.161.1.33** for the preferred DNS server
16. Enter **134.161.1.39** for the alternate DNS server
17. Click OK on both Windows

To Dial-up:

1. Double click on the **UNI dial-up** icon on the desktop.
2. To connect, use your VMS (ACAD) username and password.
