**POSITION:**

**Two-Year Renewable Term Appointment: Instructor of Voice (Tenor).** Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Provide instruction to undergraduate and graduate voice majors. Teach assigned courses according to departmental need and instructor's area(s) of expertise. Actively recruit and advise voice students and participate in service responsibilities as required. The successful candidate may be required to maintain an active performance portfolio, both on and off campus.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

Master's degree in music (minimum) plus at least 5 years experience teaching voice at the university level is required. (Earned Doctorate preferred.) Demonstrated achievement as a professional singer and proficiency in English, German, French, and Italian diction are also required. Pre-employment background checks are required.

**DEPARTMENT:**

The School of Music ([www.uni.edu/music](http://www.uni.edu/music)) includes 36 full-time faculty, 13 adjunct instructors and approximately 300 undergraduate and graduate majors. It is fully accredited by the National Association of Schools of Music and offers the following degrees: B.A. (Music): B.M. (Music Education, Composition-Theory, and Performance): M.M.
