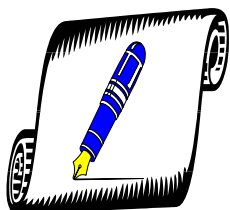
(Note: - Phil says the Boy Scouts would be willing to take our "stuff" as a donation. We might consider having a plate with our Club's name on it.)

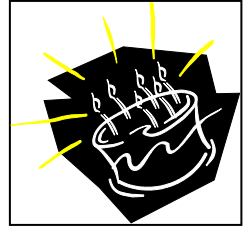
