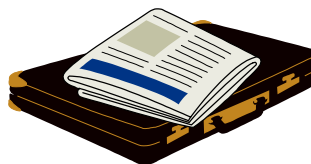

BOARD ACTION and BUSINESS MEETING

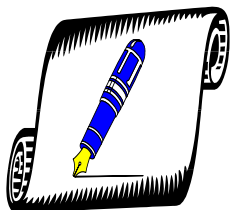


It was decided to give \$250 to a local group to help sponsor a weekend for handicapped children (Day Camp) while the parents are invited to take part in sessions that are helpful to them.

There were no repercussions over snowed-out flags on 11 Nov.

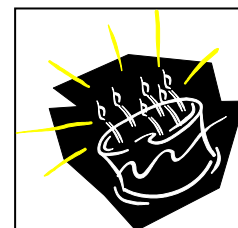
