1979...Pitched for Ionia Iowa. He was picked up by Cresco Sovereign Grain for the Iowa Major state tournament helping team to a fourth-place finish with a 3-2 record behind Des Moines Bombers, Cedar Rapids Welty Way and Sully Plumbing and Heating.

1980... Pitched his Ionia team to Class B state title defeating Graettinger twice on the final day throwing a six-hitter and five-hitter.

1982...Pitched with Cresco Sovereign Grain in Class A state.

1983...Pitched West Union Sundown Lounge in Major state throwing a 2-hitter against Cedar Rapids Storm before losing to Sioux City Penn Corp and Cedar Rapids Vigortone.

1984...Pitched West Union Sundown Budweiser team to a third place finish in Iowa Major state tournament with a 4-2 record being named to the All-Tournament team. In the Mid-America Regional tourney in Lincoln Nebraska pitched his team to a fourth-place finish among 22 teams with a 6-2 record.

1985...Pitched West Union Sundown Lounge to a 2-2 record in Iowa Major state finishing seventh.

1986...Pitched for Waterloo Turf Control. Won the 32 team Midwest Classic championship in Fort Dodge winning six games and allowing only five runs. Finished 5th at Iowa Major state tournament with a 2-1 record pitching a one-hitter and a four-hitter. Regional tournament in Omaha he beat Jefferson City Missouri 2-0 on a one-hitter raising his record to 35-13 with 22 shutouts.

1987...Pitched for Waterloo Universal Financial Services (UFS) in the Cedar Rapids Major Open League compiling a 7-4 record with a 1.94 ERA. Won the ISC state championship to become the first Waterloo team to play in the ISC World Tournament. Pitched 7 games in the Iowa Major state winning 5 and a team 3rd place finish. In the five games he won he had two shutouts allowed seven runs and 19 hits. In Major Regional in Kansas City he led Waterloo to four victories and another third-place finish with a 2-1 pitching record.

1988...Pitched Waterloo UFS to a second-place finish in the CR Major Open League with his 5-4 record and 1.51 ERA. Seventh place finish in the Iowa Major state with a pitching 1-2 record. Pitched team to the ISC state championship winning Most Valuable Pitching award. At the ISC World team finished fifteenth with Joe pitching a six-hitter in a 2-1 upset of former National Champion Seattle Pay N Pak.

1989...Pitched part time with Waterloo Kent Feeds in tournaments and the ISC Travel league leading the league in innings pitched and shutouts. Pitched with his local Clarksville Bremer County Merchants in districts and after being eliminated in sub-state was picked up by Geneva Grain for Class A state where he threw two three-hitters and a seven-hitter going 3-0 as Geneva Grain went 5-0 for the state title. At the Class A nationals in Indiana he had a 2-1 pitching record winning on a six-hitter and a five-hitter with 14 strikeouts.

1990...Pitched for Clarksville team to win Class A state from the loser bracket beating Marcus Merchants twice on the final day to complete a 6-1 record.

1991...Pitched for Clarksville going 0-2 at Iowa Major state.

1992...Pitched for Waverly NC+ Hybrids leading team to a fifth-place finish at Iowa Major state with a 2-2 pitching record. Regional tournament in Cedar Rapids Waverly tied for seventh going 2-2.

1993...Pitched Waverly NC+ Hybrids to a seventh place finish at the Iowa Major state tournament with a 2-2 pitching record.

1994...Pitched Waverly NC+ Hybrids tie for ninth place with a 1-2 record at the Iowa Major state tournament.

1995...Pitched Waverly to a second place finish at the class A state tournament.

1996...Pitched Waverly NC+ Hybrids to fourth place in the Iowa Major state tournament.

1997...Pitched with Waverly Bremer County Merchants.

1998...Pitched Clarksville Merchants to a sixth place finish at the Iowa Major Major state tournament. In Major regional in Cedar Rapids pitched his team to 5th place finish with a 2-2 record.

1999...Pitched Clarksville Merchants to a ninth-place finish in the Iowa Class A state tournament.

2000...Pitched for Holland Merchants finishing 9th at the Iowa Class A state tournament.
