<b>Planner Advisement Report</b>	No Equivalent	Report that will feed to Plan by My Requirements.	aka: PLANR
<b>User ID</b>	UNI ID	Person Using the System	rajones
<b>ID</b>	UNI ID	Student number	442140
<b>Requirement Group</b>	--	1 <sup>st</sup> level in rule hierachy. Gathers a set of requirements for the student. Dark purple line.	EX: University Requirement, Major, Minor (RG-54321)
<b>Academic Requirement</b>	--	2nd level in rule hierachy. Does the "work" of the rule. Between purple lines.	(RQ-12345)
<b>Requirement Line</b>	--	Indicate the number of courses or units required, verified or limited. Yellow triangle only	(LN-010)
<b>Course List</b>	--	Gather the course(s) needed for the Requirement Line.	Each has a 5-digit course list number, but it will not show on the report.
