

PREPARING FOR STUDENT TEACHING

A Checklist

FALL 2006 and Spring 2007

Have I:

- read the *Compass* (www.uni.edu/teached/) the College of Education publication that charts my course through the UNI Teacher Education Program?
- been fully admitted to the Teacher Education Program? This is a requirement before I can register for any Level II class.
- attended Student Teaching Round-Up on August 22 or August 23, 2005, if I plan on student teaching in Fall 2006, or have I attended Student Teaching Round-Up on January 9 or January 10, 2006, if I plan on student teaching in Spring 2007? Have I picked up my student teaching packet of materials? If I was unable to attend the Round-Up meeting because of class conflicts, did I view the video tape of the meeting in the IRTS Lab in Schindler 222?
- met **all** grade point average requirements for student teaching?
 - a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher on work at all colleges and universities?
 - a UNI GPA of 2.50 or higher?
 - a 2.50 GPA in my academic department (major)?
Note: Math majors are required to have a departmental GPA of 2.25 or higher AND departmental approval.
 - a 2.50 or higher cumulative GPA in courses completed in the Professional Education Program?
 - a grade of C (2.00) or higher on all methods courses listed as prerequisites for student teaching?
NOTE: Check for specific department requirements when more than one professional methods course is required. Early Childhood, Elementary, Middle School/Junior High School and Special Education majors are required to have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and not lower than a C (2.00) in methods courses that are required prerequisites for student teaching.
- met all other departmental requirements?
 - Note: Health Education and Physical Education majors are required to have current First Aid and CPR certification prior to student teaching.
- written all the student teaching meeting dates and deadlines on my personal calendar?
