16 WHEREAS: The University of Northern Iowa is an institution dedicated to study; and

18 WHEREAS: The Northern Iowa Student Government seeks to support students in all their
19 endeavors; and

21 RECOGNIZING: The Seerley Hall Great Reading Room is an ideal place for student and faculty
22 study; and discovery and

24 RECOGNIZING: The Great Reading Room is often locked and closed to regular student access;

27 RECOGNIZING: Seerley Hall lacks adequate, dedicated study spaces for students and;

29 RECOGNIZING: The Great Reading Room has served UNI students for decades as a space for
30 study, reading, and learning; and

32 RECOGNIZING: The Great Reading Room houses important art and artifacts central to the
33 university's history; and

35 RECOGNIZING: Students of history, the student body as a whole, and faculty would benefit from
36 an additional area for exploration, discovery, study, and reading; and

38 RECOGNIZING: The Great Reading Room is often not in use and sits empty

40 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: The Northern Iowa Student Government recommends that
41 the Seerley Hall Great Reading Room be opened for student and faculty staff when not reserved for
42 other engagements during normal, university-approved business hours; with appropriate restrictions
43 on food and beverage so as to maintain the room
